2023 Youth Heifer Program

Applications due September 30, 2022



Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the 2023 Midwest Heritage Youth Heifer Program.

The purpose of the Youth Heifer Program is to provide an opportunity for the next generation of farmers to gain experience in the cattle industry by managing their own herd.

Midwest Heritage will select up to five students to receive three bred heifers. Applicants are chosen based on merit, future goals and capacity to care for their herd.

The market value of the heifers is established at the beginning of the program and financed as a 0% interest loan that the recipients repay at the completion of the five year program. Participants are responsible for managing their herd through daily care, record keeping, and breeding.

The Youth Heifer Program allows participants to learn financial literacy, budgeting and herd management skills that provide the opportunity to repay the loan and save for the future.

Program Guidelines/Eligibility

- Applicants must be a 7th or 8th grade student (as of fall of 2022) residing in Adair, Lucas, Madison, Wayne or Warren County, Iowa.
- Participant must maintain accurate records of income, expenditures and brief summary of activities and submit these records annually.
- Participant must pay back Midwest Heritage the market value of the bred heifers over a five year period. The market value is established when the herd is received.
- Must be willing to promote Midwest Heritage and the Youth Heifer Program in their community.
- Applications and letters of recommendation are due by September 30, 2022.
- Winners will be notified by October 13, 2022.

Deadline for application is September 30, 2022.
